INTRODUCTION

Welcome to Britain's unique and priceless heritage of Church Music, enjoyed by the many thousands of people who visit our cathedrals and collegiate chapels, in search of choral and organ music. In Britain we have much fine music written specially for the Church, which demands considerable skill from the singers and players involved in performing it.

Cathedrals and collegiate chapels come alive when highly trained choirs sing a service. Traditionally these are made up of boys and men, however today a number of cathedrals give girls the opportunity to sing the top line with the men of the choir, or to sing on their own as a group. These choirs can draw upon the works of British composers of sacred music from the past and present, as well as those written by other composers of the western European musical tradition. Indeed, most of these were employed by the Roman Catholic, and later the Protestant churches. This music is now sung worldwide in the cathedrals, collegiate chapels and churches of the Protestant Anglican Communion and also the Roman Catholic Church. Since Catholic Emancipation in 1829 the two churches have coexisted with increasing closeness.

Many of the directors of music and organists working within the Anglican liturgical music network have been trained in England, where this rich tradition has been handed down for over a thousand years. It is important to emphasize that the Reformation here, which followed the Church of England's breakaway from Rome, did not interrupt this creative flow of liturgical and sacred music. The musicians composing for the Church at the time switched from Latin to English texts in their music for the new liturgy. The composers living in the countries which espoused the Protestant Lutheran and Calvinist Churches likewise changed to using their own languages. As a result present-day choirs have to be prepared to sing in German, French and Italian, as well as English and Latin.

All the choral services listed in this guide are open to the public. The Friends of Cathedral Music, the publisher of *Singing in Cathedrals*, hope it helps to lead you to choral worship wherever it is offered, in both Britain and Ireland.

SINGING IN CATHEDRALS

A Directory of choral services in cathedrals, collegiate churches, chapels and other choral foundations in Great Britain, and the Republic of Ireland.

NB Only choral services are listed.

(1) The information in this directory was compiled in July 2008, and every effort was made to ensure its accuracy but unforeseen changes do occur from time to time, and for various reasons. The choir's rest day, for instance, is usually moved if it falls on a Saint's Day.

(2) Most cathedral choirs enjoy a holiday for a few weeks after Christmas and Easter, and there is usually a break halfway through each term. The main summer holidays are normally from mid-July until early September (end of June to mid-August in Scotland). Visiting choirs sing services at some cathedrals when the resident choir is on holiday.

(3) Visitors are advised to check in advance with the cathedral, college or other foundation concerned, using the telephone number, fax or e-mail address provided in this guide, to ensure that the services advertised will be sung on the day of the visit. Please note all telephone and fax numbers shown in this guide are in their British format.

(4) Where *Common Worship* is in use for the Eucharist, the directory indicates, when known, which 'order' is used e.g. CW01, indicating Order One. Where the liturgy is taken from the traditional *Book of Common Prayer* (1662) it is indicated by the letters BCP. Numbering against a Sunday indicates its place in the month (some months have five Sundays).

(5) The letters GT indicate the telephone number to call for enquiries about guided tours, or other access information.

This broadcast will be repeated the following Sunday at 1600hrs. Radio 3 can be listened to on VHF/FM 90.2 - 92.4 MHz, or on the digital network (DAB), Sky 853, Freeview, Freesat, Dcable and on the internet via the BBC Radio 3 website at: www.bbc.co.uk/radio3/listen live (during transmission) or 'listen again' to repeat the last broadcast for up to 7 days afterwards.

The *Choral Evensong* schedule, together with music details, is available directly at: www.bbc.co.uk/radio3/choral evensong or it can be accessed via the *Choral Evensong* programme page from the Radio 3 home page.

There is the *Daily Service* on Radio 4 at 09.45 Mon-Fri (LW only). Also on R4 at 08.10 there is *Sunday Worship*, and on R2 at 20.30 there is *Sunday Half Hour* which is devoted to hymn singing. There are also occasional live or recorded choral services broadcast at other times on Radio 3 or Radio 4; e.g. at Advent, Christmas, Easter and Ascension. Full details are always given in Radio Times.

The organ was built by TC Lewis in 1878, then rebuilt by Harrison between 1912 and 1926. The distinctive, dark oak organ casing was designed by Sir Gilbert Scott for the Lewis organ. One of the last tonal additions was the installation in 1996 of a Solo Orchestral Trumpet *en chamade*. At this time the organ was fitted with an 8-channel solid-state combination system. In 2000 a generous gift funded the provision of a mobile console for the floor of the nave, which is used for services in that area and for concerts and recitals.
